RULES FOR ONE DAY COMPETITION

Jack Robinson

Teams drawn randomly by number generating machine from all entries, separated into leads, skips and two's.

4 games to be played, 3 of 5 ends and 1 of 6 ends. Winners move up after each set of ends.

Score to be accumulated for each game both for and against.

Each member of the team must play in each position at least once i.e. as skip, number 2 and lead.

Teams to toss for the jack at the start of each section.

Each team can decide in which order they are going to play from the start.

Winners are the team who score the highest number of shots for. Shot difference will only be used if more than one teams scores are the same.

No changes

Presidents Trophy

This is a yardstick competition played over 3 games of 6 ends.

Game 1 is played to a minimum jack length with the mat at the 2 metre mark (use the stick if you are not sure) and the jack set at 23 metres. If the jack is moved it is to be put back to where it was.

Game 2 is the same but with the jack at maximum length. Again if the jack is moved it should be repositioned.

Game 3 is with the mat and jack set as normal. If the jack is moved it stays where it has moved to. There will be no firing allowed.

There are no trial ends.

Teams move right or left as indicated on their score cards after each game of 6 ends. Each team must keep their own score as a running total with the highest score to decide the winners. In the event of a tie the teams involved will play extra ends until a winner is decided.

Changes:

Game 2 jack full length with mat right up

Game 3 mat and jack optional position i.e. mat and jack at any legal position

Two Wood Singles

Games will be over 21 ends with no trial ends. Toss for the jack. Final to be played on singles final day.

Changes:

Games to be played in two groups over 18 ends Final may be played on day or finals day decided by finalists

Mixed Triples

Players will be segregated into leads, two's and skips.

Each triple will include at least one lady with teams drawn out of the hat.

Number of ends decided on the day.

Changes:

Played in groups as dictated by numbers 45 minutes per game Nick to run this competition in 2024

Mrs Carver Trophy

Pairs drawn with leads and skips.

Play will be over 2 sets of first to 7 shots in a round robin format, with 1 point for a drawn set and 2 points for a win.

Shot difference to decide in the event of a drawn group.

The final to be played over 3 sets to 7 shots.

Changes:

In two groups, 3 games each 2 sets of 5 shots.

The final to be played over 3 sets to 5 shots
